Call for four consultants: Moderating the multistakeholder meeting on HIV & Mental health

About the project

The HIV & Mental Health project aims to explore the existing knowledge about the interplay of mental health, well-being and HIV and translate it into practical recommendations for both community organisations and healthcare professionals in the European context. In 2020 and 2021, EATG carried out a literature review, a community [survey](#) on mental health and HIV and convened two workshops to discuss results and implications for health service providers and community organisations. A briefing paper providing a summary of recommendations that emerged from these to improve the provision of mental health services for people living with and affected by HIV in Europe and Central Asia has been published. To ensure the sustainability of the project, a European network bringing together the different stakeholders in the field of mental health and HIV will be formed and a platform for them to interact will be established.

The project focuses on the region of Europe and Central Asia and is conducted in English and Russian.

Job description and proposed timeline

The consultant(s) will be responsible for the following tasks:

- Moderate break-out sessions, a focus group and a discussion panel during the multistakeholder meeting on HIV & Mental health organized by EATG on Thursday 18/11/2021 and on Friday 19/11/2021 in Sitges (SPAIN)

The consultant will collaborate with the EATG staff, the Project Officer, the Programme Manager, if relevant, the Quality of Life Programme Committee, and with any Consultants contracted for the project.
